Course Description: Canadian OHS laws require managers and supervisors to understand applicable OHS legislation and the meaning of "due diligence". Due diligence is a legal defence to OHS charges and has two specific requirements. First, employers must demonstrate that they have established an OHS management system to identify, assess and control workplace hazards. Second, employers must demonstrate that they have effectively implemented the OHS management system.
